### **Associated Student Body Cards:**

All students receive an Associated Student Body ID Card (ASB) by October. **Students are required to carry their ASB card everyday on campus and to all Pioneer activities.** The sticker on the card is available with the Pride Package. It gives ASB card sticker holders reduced prices and/or free entry to school events. There is a \$10.00 charge for a replacement card.

### **Debt Clearance:**

Students must be cleared of all school debts before a schedule will be issued. Individual debt notices were mailed in June.

### **Emergency Form:**

Enclosed is the Annual Student Emergency form. This form must be reviewed/updated/signed by a parent/guardian and be turned in at Registration in order for the student to receive a schedule. Contacts listed are the only individuals to whom your child will be released without prior consent.

### **Food:**

Pioneer sells food at brunch and lunch from their food court, satellite carts, and the school store. Food Services sends separate information about pre-purchasing food and free and reduced lunch. Applications for free and reduced lunch should be returned as soon as possible.

**Health Office:**

In order to take any medication at school, a doctor's note and form needs to be on file. Forms are available in the Health Office.

**ID Photos:**

All freshmen, sophomore and junior students will have their photo taken at registration (order form included). Senior photos are taken by appointment at Jim Nelson Photography, 264-7811.

**Mustang Pride Package:**

The Mustang Pride Package supports Pioneer High School and is a convenient way to purchase popular items such as the ASB sticker, Yearbook and PTSA membership. See insert for additional information.

**Parking Permits:**

Parking permits are for sale in the bank during the school year for \$20.00. Driver's license and proof of insurance are necessary to purchase a permit. All student vehicles must display a Pioneer High School parking permit. Students are strongly encouraged to park at Pioneer rather than on neighborhood streets.

**PE Athletic Physicals:**

All students participating in a sport must have a sports physical before starting the sport. The forms are available in the Student Services office. Please plan ahead in making an appointment with your physician.

**PE Uniforms:**

PE uniforms are on sale at registration and in PE class the first week of school. The cost is \$24.00 for the top and bottom. Sweat pants are \$15.00.
