	<b>Class Schedule Distribution</b>	Help before school starts to distribute class schedule to students and textbook distribution
	<b>Academic Awards Assemblies</b>	Help before the day of the event with folding invitations and stuffing envelopes. Help on the day of event with prep and passing out programs. (Usually late morning)
	<b>Art Showcase &amp; Auction</b>	Help before and the day of the event. Example: Planning for event, prepare art for display, ticket sales, mailing to art students, event setup.
	<b>Pioneer Pride Days - Campus Rejuvenation</b>	Assist with gardening and cleanup. Donate supplies, plants, and landscaping materials and funds.
	<b>Senior Events</b>	These events occur in June: Senior Awards Night, Senior Breakfast, Grad Night.
	<b>Hospitality and Events Support</b>	Volunteer to donate food and time for various school events. Example: Service Learning events, Senior Events, Teacher in-service breakfasts, Teacher Appreciation Week, Chaperone Dances.
	<b>General PTSA Volunteer</b>	Assist PTSA with activities as needed.
	<b>Education Foundation Volunteer</b>	Parent and teacher organization to support academic programs and technology. Need volunteers to help with Foundation events and activities such as taking on a leadership position, e-Waste, grant writing, and helping with other events.
	<b>Athletic Booster Volunteer</b>	Parent support group for all athletics at Pioneer. Activities and events include membership drive, concessions at all five home football games, Mustang logo clothing sales, Crab Feed fundraiser, Mustang Stampede golf tournament fundraiser, athletics eScript. Monthly meetings are every third Wednesday of the month.
	<b>Pioneer &amp; Community Involvement</b>	Be a School Board Observer twice a month (generally 1st & 3rd Thursday) or attend monthly Brown Bag Lunches with superintendent and report back to PTSA.
	<b>Clerical/Office/Library</b>	Help teachers and office by making copies and/or data entry. Help in the Library with shelving books. You can pick your shift or volunteer a few hours each week.
	<b>Student Bank/Student Store</b>	Clerical help, particularly as school starts. Shifts for selling food at the window for the store during brunch and lunch throughout the school year. Lots of help needed.
	<b>General Support</b>	From time to time different opportunities arise. This can be a special activity or helping with a particular event. If you are willing to help, you'll be contacted when needed for a specific activity.
